



Spring Registration 2010

The Spring Registration deadline for both State and District competition teams is Thursday, January 14th, 2010. All teams must turn in their registration paperwork and fees to their league registrars by January 14th or will need to pay a \$50 late fee and run the risk that their team may not be accepted for Spring play.

New or Returning Team?

We are currently in the middle of the 2009/10 playing season. Generally, teams form in June and remain together through May of the following year, though their player's cards are actually valid through the summer tournament season, expiring at the end of July. Teams that registered in June of 2009 for the Fall season and wish to re-register for the Spring 2010 season are Returning teams. Teams that did not play in the Fall of 2009 and wish to register to play in the Spring of 2010 are New Teams.
